## Happy Summer!

Did you ever go to summer camp as a kid? Maybe you went to Girl or Boy Scout camp. Or maybe you went to a camp that your extended family always attended together. Perhaps, especially if you were from the East Coast, you went to one of those allsummer-long camps. Or maybe you went to a Christan camp. When I was a kid, I went to both Boy Scout Camp (down at Pico Blanco Boy Scout Reservation near Big Sur), and I went to camps at Mount Hermon Christian Conference Center. As a young adult, I worked summers at Pico Blanco, Mount Hermon's Redwood Camp, and one of those Easter rich-kid all-summer-long camps, in addition to volunteer counseling at other camps around the country, including the Presbyterian Westminster Woods in Occidental.

So you might say camping is in my blood! Especially the Christian camps I've been a part of.

I think a week at a Christian camp is one of the most amazing experiences any child or teen can have. You spend a week away from the prying eyes of mom and dad, meet counselors who really aren't all that much older than you and who like to hang out with you, and you get to make a bunch of new friends with kids your own age. You play lots of crazy games, learn some new skills, enjoy the great outdoors, and, unique to Christian camps, you get to learn more about Jesus and your relationship to him. It was at Redwood Camp that I made the decision to follow Christ, even though I'd been raised in the church and called myself a Christian (this was the

summer before my 7<sup>th</sup> grade year, sitting at the firepit with my counselor "Chickenlegs"). My faith grew stronger as I moved up the hill to Ponderosa Lodge, the high school center, and I started to learn to play guitar. It was on staff at Redwood Camp that I first heard the call to the ministry. And because camp was so important to me, I wanted other kids to have that same experience, and why I worked and volunteered at so many camps.

"What makes camp special?" you might ask. I think that being in the nature that God created makes you feel closer to God. I think that being with your peers who are on the same path you are lets you know that you are not the only one. And counselors and other leaders who love Jesus are there sharing their relationship with the Lord with you.

We call that a "mountaintop experience." Moses had a mountaintop experience with the Lord God on Mount Sinai when he received the Ten Commandments. When he came down, it is said that he "glowed" so much he had to put a cloth over his face to protect the people. Peter, James and John had a mountaintop experience when they went up the mountain with Jesus and saw him "transfigured" and joined by Moses and Elijah. They came off the mountain transformed, and ready to spread the gospel to all the ends of the earth.

Vacation Bible School is often a "mountaintop experience" for kids, even if there isn't a mountain! This is for many of the same reasons—having fun with your peers and learning from caring adults. Our VBS theme this year is "Camp Firelight: A Summer Camp Experience with God." We'll transform the church into a summer camp, complete with trees, streams, butterflies and more! And caring youth and adults like you will share the love of Jesus with the children who come.

So, if you can, volunteer to help us out! We need people who can check kids in each day, who can lead recreation, who can "sing and dance" (as our Rebekah likes to say!) and more! And we need people to PRAY for the kids and staff who are here for the week. Perhaps some of the kids who come will have a life-changing "mountaintop experience" as well.

Camp Firelight begins on June 17 and ends on June 21. On Sunday, June 23, be sure to join us in worship as we celebrate all we did during VBS!


