Dear friends,

On November 27, the new liturgical year started. It is the season of Advent, the season of preparation for the coming of our Lord, Jesus Christ, both as we celebrate the incarnation at Christmas, and as we anticipate the second coming. The first Sunday of Advent always looks at the coming eschatology (the second coming) of Christ, and warns us to "keep awake." One of my favorite Advent hymns is *"Sleepers, Wake! A Voice Astounds Us,* set to J.S. Bach's glorious tune, *Wachet Auf.* The Advent readings, as echoed by this great hymn, remind us to keep awake, to be alert, for we do not know when the second coming will be.

So what does that mean—keep awake? Does it really mean we shouldn't sleep for the next who-knows-howlong? Of course not. It means to do the right things, to be living our lives "decently, as in the daytime, not in orgies and drunkenness, not in sexual immorality and debauchery, not in dissension and jealousy, [the things we keep secret in the dark]." (Romans 13:13) Instead we...

• Pray continuously. (1 Thessalonians 5:16)

- Feed the hungry. (Romans 12:20)
- Visit the sick. (Matthew 25:36)
- Love everyone. (John 15:12)
- Welcome the stranger. (Matthew 25:35)

Most, if not all of you!, are living this out. Let us continue to do so. As we prepare for Christmas—putting up lights, hanging wreaths and garland, decorating the tree, baking cookies, buying and wrapping gifts—remember to also continue to serve the stranger and care for those in need, keeping in mind that that is what the incarnate God, Jesus the Christ, did in his brief time on this earth.



1. Mix your favorite cutout cookie recipe.

2. Chill overnight.

3. On waxed paper, roll dough into thin ropes, about 6" long.

4. Shape ropes into holiday symbols – stars, bells, etc.
5. Crush hard candies to make 2 cups.

7. Fill the openings with hard candies.

8. Use a toothpick to poke a hole in the top of each if you want to hang them.

9. Bake for 8 minutes, or until candy melts.
